



HUNTER INSIGHTS SHORT BREAK

Thursday 21st May to Sunday 24th May 2009

We invite you to join us for the first section of our Hunter Insights tour. You will travel from Thirroul by airconditioned chartered coach to Cessnock in the heart of the Hunter Valley. The first highlight of your short break is a private chartered ferry cruise on the Hawkesbury River with lunch served on board. The tour will take you to historic Hunter towns, the Richmond Vale Mining and Railway Museum and the long established Drayton's Family Winery near Pokolbin. You will also have the experience of travelling on our chartered private railcar train as we travel to the Upper Hunter Region of Singleton and Muswellbrook.

Hunter Insights Short Break is an all inclusive and fully escorted tour.

DAY 1 Thursday 21st May Thirroul to Cessnock



This morning we travel by coach from Thirroul to Berowra where we board our chartered heritage ferry "Macquarie Princess" for a leisurely cruise on Berowra Waters and the Hawkesbury River. In the afternoon we continue to Cessnock in the heart of the Hunter Valley. We stay for 2 nights at Cessnock.

DAY 2 Friday 22nd May Cessnock

Today we tour the Hunter district in the vicinity of Cessnock, which was first settled in 1826. It is named after Cessnock Castle in Scotland and is now the heart of the Hunter Valley wine-producing region with many of the iconic Australian wineries being located in the surrounding

area. There is also an enormous coal mining industry for which Cessnock is one of the principal service towns. This morning we have a guided tour of Cessnock before visiting the Richmond Vale Railway and the coal mining museum. We will have a specially chartered steam train ride on the Richmond Vale line then a barbeque lunch. This afternoon we will visit Drayton's Winery at Pokolbin for inspection and tastings of their wines.

DAY 3 Saturday 23rd May Cessnock to Muswellbrook



This morning we board the railmotors at Maitland and proceed to Singleton where we have a guided inspection of the Royal Australian Infantry Corps Museum situated at the Singleton Army Barracks. The museum has a collection of infantry equipment, uniforms, weapons and memorabilia including a history of the Royal Australian Regiment's campaigns from Korea through to current peacekeeping operations. We then transfer to the restored Sisters of Mercy convent, Sacred Spaces, for a tour of their buildings. The convent is one of several significant 19th century buildings in Singleton and has been occupied by the nuns since 1875. Reboard the railmotors for Muswellbrook where we have a town tour before arriving at the motel. A self guided heritage walk can be taken at your leisure during our stay in Muswellbrook.

DAY 4 Sunday 24th May Muswellbrook

The tour concludes after a full country breakfast.

You may choose to enjoy the morning and relax before boarding the Countrylink Explorer train to Sydney.

Railmotors

Insights Tours has chartered two CPH (CPH1 and 7) railmotors from Paterson Railmotor Society. The railmotors are 1920's vintage and have total seating for 76, however the tour will be limited to 38 passengers to ensure comfortable and spacious travelling. There is a flushing toilet in each railmotor. The railmotors are not airconditioned and have opening windows. Complimentary morning or afternoon tea and coffee will be served by the hospitality attendants.

Coach

Insights Tours has chartered a coach which is airconditioned, toilet equipped and has well spaced seating. The coach will be utilised for all road travel and transfers. Once placed aboard the coach each day your luggage is transferred to the motel for that evening leaving you to relax and enjoy the journey.

Accommodation

All accommodation is of at least a 3 star standard. Ground floor accommodation is available upon request. The cost of the tour is based on twin share ensuite accommodation.

Limited single accommodation is available for an additional cost of \$130.

Luggage

Please limit your luggage to 1 suitcase and 1 piece of hand luggage per person. Please note that portage of luggage is not provided but can be arranged at additional supplement if desired.
